What do we know about migration?

The Centre for Research and Analysis of Migration (CReAM) at UCL has today launched a briefing document “What do we know about migration?” to inform the debate on migration.

The document summarises the key findings on 10 issues that relate to immigration, such as innovation and trade, fiscal and labour market effects, education, the health system and housing, and crime and international development. It points out the state of research on these issues, and at the same time explains the challenges to obtaining reliable figures.

The document is intended as a resource for the interested observer, to inform about the state of research on these issues in relationship to the UK, and to provide further references for in depth study.
